Hunt Military Communities now offers a way for you to pay your rent with cash. The WIPS (Walk In Payment Service) program launched January 19, 2021.

This is How it Works

- 1) Log into your Hunt Resident Portal/App to get a mobile bar code or your printed payslip.
- 2) Show your barcode to any participating CVS Pharmacy or 7-Eleven to make a cash payment.
- 3) Keep your receipt. Hunt Resident Portal is notified of your payment the next business day.

Medal of Honor Day is celebrated every year on March 25. It was created to honor the "heroism and sacrifice of Medal of Honor recipients for the United States." The holiday has been celebrated since 1991, when George H. W. Bush signed into public law on November 15, 1990. The holiday was chosen to be celebrated on March 25 to honor the 23 men who participated in the Great Locomotive Chase and received Medals of Honor for it, particularly William Bensing, Robert Buffum, Elihu H. Mason, Jacob Parrott, William Pittenger, and William H. H. Reddick, who received the first six Medals of Honor on March 25, 1863.
